## SHOW RULES

1. This show is to be governed by the latest rules of the ARBA, and filing an entry indicates acceptance of the same.
2. The Golden Prairie RBA will not be responsible for loss from Fire, Theft, Accidents, or Providential Destruction. Every Precaution will be taken to prevent the same.
3. Specials, received too late for listing in this catalog, will be posted in the showroom.
4. The club reserves the right to substitute another judge, in case of unavailability of the first selection.
5. ENTRY FEE: Single rabbit - \$2.50. Fur/Wool entries \$1.00. (OPEN and YOUTH).
6. Fur entries must be labeled if they are to be Breed or General fur class. Fur entries are shown in their BREED class.
7. This will be a carrying case show only. ALL cases MUST BE solid bottomed.
8. ALL stock must be Permanently, and LEGIBLY, tattooed in the left ear.
9. All rabbits for Open and Youth must be in the showroom by 8:00 a.m.
12. Ribbons will be awarded through 3rd Place, and must be picked up the day of the show. Rosettes will be awarded for Best and Best Opposite of Breeds with 10 or more entered.
13. Plaques, for Best Six Class and Best Four Class, and Plaques for Best In Show will be awarded in both shows.
14. No payback other than what ARBA requires.
15. An ARBA registrar will be available. If you wish to register your animals, bring your current ARBA membership card and pedigrees.
16. NO SPECIALS WILL BE PAID UNLESS 10 OR MORE RABBITS ARE SHOWN IN THE BREED. We will pay \$2.00 Best of Breed and \$1.00 Best opposite Sex for any breed not sanctioned, provided there are 10 or more shown of the breed.
17. No shipped in rabbits will be accepted.
18. ARBA entry forms and remark cards or rabbit computer software entry forms will be accepted.
19. Any breeds with less than 10 rabbits show will not be sanctioned the following year unless paid by an exhibitor. Any sanction paid for by an exhibitor with 20 or more rabbits show will be refunded by the club.
20. The ARBA host club reserves the right to refuse entries from all locations within 150 miles which has had a confirmed outbreak of RCD/RHD/VHD within the past 60 days of the entry deadline.
21. The GPRBA is not responsible for catalog errors or omissions.

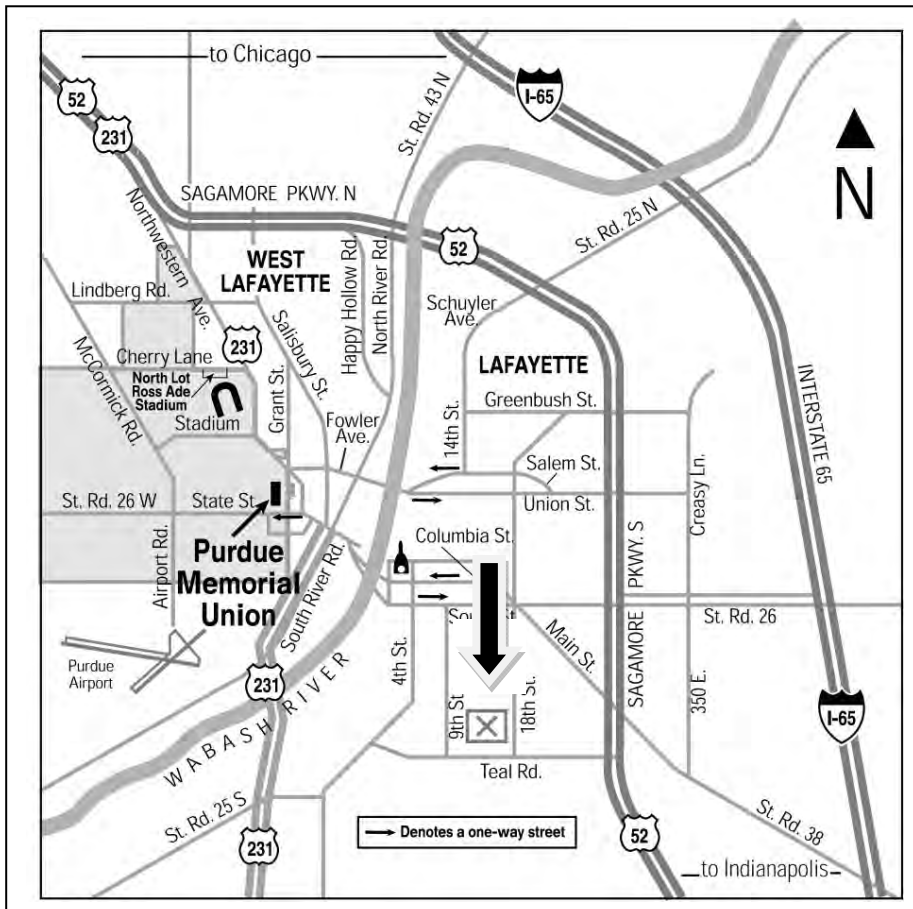
**Driving Directions:**

From the South and Northwest: I-65 to Exit #168 (HWY 38) go west from the interstate exit, passing SIA auto plant to Sagamore Parkway (HWY 52). Turn left onto Sagamore Parkway, go 1/2 mile to Teal Road (stoplight), turn right onto Teal and go 2 miles and enter fairgrounds on your right. Swine barn is off to the left.

From the Southwest: Take US 231 or HWY 25 to Lafayette. At the intersection of US 231 (four lane section) and HWY 25 take old 25 east into Lafayette turning left on old 231 and 4th street. At Carter Lumber and old 231/4th street turn left and travel about 1 mile to a stoplight at the bottom of the hill. Teal Road intersects at this stoplight. Take Teal Road right about 1 1/2 miles and turn left into the fairgrounds. Swine barn will be off to the left once you enter the fairgrounds.

From the West and Northwest: Bring HWY 26 or HWY 43 into West Lafayette and follow US 231 south across the Wabash River until you come to a stoplight and the intersection of US 231/HWY 25 & 43. Turn left or east onto old 25 traveling to old 231 and 4th street (Carter Lumber), turn left and travel about 1 mile to a stoplight at the bottom of the hill. Teal Road intersects at this stoplight. Take Teal Road right about 1 1/2 miles and turn left into the fairgrounds. Swine barn will be off to the left once you enter the fairgrounds.

From the East: Bring HWY 26 or HWY 28 to I-65. HWY 26 go south on I-65 and if on HWY 28 go north onto I-65. At exit #168 (HWY 38) go west from the interstate exit, passing SIA auto plant to Sagamore Parkway (HWY 52). Turn left onto Sagamore Parkway, go 1/2 mile to Teal Road (stoplight and BW3 Bar and Grill), turn right onto Teal and go 2 miles and enter fairgrounds on your right. Swine barn is off to the left.
