Show Rules

1. All ARBA and ACBA rules will be followed. Pre-entries are preferred and will be at a lower entry fee. If you make an email entry, you agree to pay the club the appropriate fees due. Day of show entries will be allowed at a higher entry fee.
2. Without exception, all entries must be paid for before judging begins. Scratched entries forfeit entry fees.
3. The Show Committee reserves the right to substitute judges as needed, and to refuse entry to any individual by showing due cause. Diseased or unsightly animals will be refused entry.
4. All entries are entered and shown at the risk of their owners. By filling an entry, exhibitor and family agree to follow these rules and agree to not hold facilitators or Pioneer Cavy Fanciers responsible for loss due to fire, theft, accident, or destruction. All precautions within reason will be taken.
5. All entries must be shown in their natural state, without evidence of dying, plucking, trimming, or foreign matter on the coat. Any faking designed to alter the natural condition or appearance is a disqualification. Normal grooming that does not alter the natural state is permitted.
6. All cavies must be permanently ear marked in the left ear or they will be disqualified. Ear tags will be available at the show for **\$1.00** each.
7. Cavies must be owned by the exhibitor; youth must be able to handle their own cavies. Open shows are for everyone; Youth shows are for ages 18 and under. Youth may show in youth and open shows.
8. It is unethical for an exhibitor to make the judge aware of ownership of an entry before it is judged. Exhibitors attempting to, or actually interfering with, annoying, molesting, influencing the judge, or acting in a manner unbecoming to exhibitors, shall have all their stock eliminated from the show.
9. **Parental guidance of children will be adhered to; show room etiquette is expected or expulsion from the show may result. Parents may not drop off children and are responsible for them at all times.**
10. No exhibitors will be allowed behind the judging tables unless acting in an official capacity.
11. All working breeds and varieties must be accompanied with a proposed Working Standard.
12. The Show Committee reserves the right to clarify the above rules and make decisions on any matters not included.

Please respect the show area. We hope to be able to come here again and want everyone to be on good behavior. Please keep your area clean and attractive. Remember this is a Towel, Wood Pellet or Paper Pellet only show!

No shavings, straw, or hay allowed. Use wood or paper pellets, care fresh bedding or towels. Carriers must be clean and presentable for the public. Exhibitors will clean their area before leaving.
